Being a homebody isn't an option at these nature-friendly residential communities



June is Great Outdoors Month no, really, it's an official U.S. Senate designation—but instead of just taking a one-time adventure trip, why not find a place where you can experience the great outdoors again and again?

Georgia's **Reynolds Lake Oconee** is built around what the development calls a "19,000-acre freshwater playground," which is a pretty apt way of looking at this residential community. You can join the Lake Oconee Anglers Club, go stand-up paddleboarding at dawn, try your luck at wakeboarding, and much more. Obviously a lakefront property is the way to go, and one option is 1070 South Grove Road, a fivebedroom home with its own dock built in 2020. It's listed for \$3.495 million on *reynoldslakeoconee.com*.

At **Tributary** in Driggs, Idaho, meanwhile, your neighbors are Grand Teton and Yellowstone National Parks. Even

closer to home you have mountain biking, hiking, skiing, trout fishing basically any outdoor activity you can imagine. The five-bedroom, 5.5bath Basecamp cabin is available for \$4.95 million at *tributaryidaho.com*.

South Carolina's The Cliffs at Keowee Springs is another adventurer's paradise. The gorgeous five-bedroom home at 222 Creek Stone Court (\$4.495 million, cliffsliving.com) overlooks Lake Keowee and is also near Devils Fork and Table Rock State Parks. The Cliffs **Exploration Series organizes monthly** hikes for residents, and there's also a new Sportsman Trail with 12 stations where you can test your weapons skills-everything from archery and ax throwing to air rifles and slingshots. (Hey, as long as it gets you outside...) The property even has special dog showers for your furry friends.
